Child – 3 to 17 and young adults who are between the ages of 18 and 21 and enrolled in a Special Education program = \$1,500 per month effective January 1, 2018

Adult – adults ages 22 and older, and adults ages 18 - 21 who are no longer in Special Education, = \$2,250 per month effective January 1, 2018

HSP – Home Support Program (DRS, not PUNS related)

ICAP – Inventory for Client and Agency Planning - Assessment Tool – Used to determine basic eligibility for developmental disabilities HCBS Waiver plus, it is an important part of the funding formula that determines your specific funding rate for CILA

ICF-DD – Intermediate Care Facilities – Developmental Disabilities

ICDD – Illinois Council on Developmental Disabilities

IDPH – Illinois Department of Public Health

ISC – Independent Service Coordination Agency

ISP – Individual Service Plan

ISSA – Individual Service and Support Advocacy

LIGAS – Services for Individuals Currently Residing in the Family Home
